Westminster Larger Catechism: Question # 70

Question: What is Justification?

Answer: Justification is an act of God's free grace unto sinners,^a in which he pardoneth all their sins, accepteth and accounteth their persons righteous his sight;^b not for any thing wrought in them, or done by them,^c but only for the perfect obedience and full satisfaction of Christ, by God imputed to them,^d and received by faith alone.^e
