Westminster Larger Catechism: Question # 71

Question: How is Justification an Act of God's Free Grace?

Answer: Although Christ, by his obedience and death, did make a proper, real, and full satisfaction to God's justice in the behalf of them that are justified;^a yet in as much as God accepteth the satisfaction from a surety, which he might have demanded of them, and did provide this surety, his own only Son,^b imputing his righteousness to them,^c and requiring nothing of them for their justification but faith,^d which also is his gift,^e their justification is to them of free grace.^f
