<sup>8</sup>Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. <sup>9</sup> Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: <sup>10</sup>But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: <sup>11</sup>For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the

LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

<sup>12</sup>Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

<sup>13</sup>Thou shalt not kill.

<sup>14</sup>Thou shalt not commit adultery.

<sup>15</sup>Thou shalt not steal.

<sup>16</sup>Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

<sup>17</sup>Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

## Westminster Larger Catechism: Question # 79

**Question:** May not true believers, by reason of their imperfections, and the many temptations and sins they are overtaken with, fall away from the state of grace ?

**Answer:** True believers, by reason of the unchangeable love of God,<sup>a</sup> and his decree and covenant to give them perseverance,<sup>b</sup> their inseparable union with Christ,<sup>c</sup> his continual intercession for them,<sup>d</sup> and the Spirit and seed of God abiding in them,<sup>e</sup> can neither totally nor finally fall away from the state of grace,<sup>f</sup> but are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation.<sup>g</sup>
