Westminster Larger Catechism: Question # 32

Question: How is the grace of God manifested in the second covenant?

Answer: The grace of God is manifested in the second covenant, in that he freely provideth and offereth to sinners a Mediator,^a and life and salvation by him;^b and requiring faith as the condition to interest them in him,^c promiseth and giveth his Holy Spirit^d to all his elect, to work in them that faith,^e with all other saving graces;^f and to enable them unto all holy obedience,^g as the evidence of the truth of their faith^h and thankfulness to God,ⁱ and as the way which he hath appointed them to salvation.^j
